YCUSD ASES after school program provides a safe and stimulating environment where Kindergarten through 8th grade. Students engage in educational enrichment and recreational activities that correspond with student's regular day school.

Program Principles:

- 1. Each site's after school program is developed in collaboration with the site staff, students, parents, YCUSD, and community partners.
- 2. Each day students who are enrolled in after school program participate in two components:
 - a. An educational component which provides tutoring and/or homework support to assist students in meeting state standards in core academic subjects such as English language arts and math.
 - b. An educational enrichment component which compliments the regular school academic program by providing students with the opportunities to participate in recreation, prevention, youth development, visual and performing arts, and career-awareness

Program:

- YCUSD ASES after school programs commence immediately upon the conclusion of the school day and remain open until 6:00P.M.
- Students in grades K-8 are able to participate in after school programs.
- Nutritious snack is served daily.
- Staff member who supervise students meet the minimum YCUSD qualification for an instructional aide.

HIVE After School Program Hours:

- Kindergarten- 12:25pm- 6:00pm
- 1st -5th grades: 2:48pm-6:00pm
- 6th,7th, 8th grades: 3:00pm-6:00pm

Rules & Disciplinary Policy

Please read the following rules with your children:

- <u>Attendance</u>: **Regular attendance is required.** The program requires your student to say 3 hours. If our child does not attend on a regular basis we will put your child on the waiting list and give their space to a child on the waiting list. Before this happens you will receive a warning call about your child's attendance.
- <u>Early Release</u>: The program requires your student to stay a minimum of 3 hours. Therefore any other early pick up needs to be accounted for.
- <u>Program Rules:</u> Students will continue to follow the same school rules established during the regular school day. If a school rule is broken the consequences apply.
 - 1. Warning: The first incident you will receive a phone call from the coordinator.
 - 2. Warning plus referral/suspension: The second incident you will receive a referral/suspension and a call home.
 - 3. Removal: The third incident your child may no longer be able to attend the after school program for the remainder of the school year

Late Pick Up: The program is over at 6:00 p.m. If your child is not picked up by 6:00 p.m. you will receive a warning. After two late pick-ups your child will be removed from the program and put at the bottom of the waiting list. If your child is not picked up by 6:15 p.m. the proper authorities will be called.
